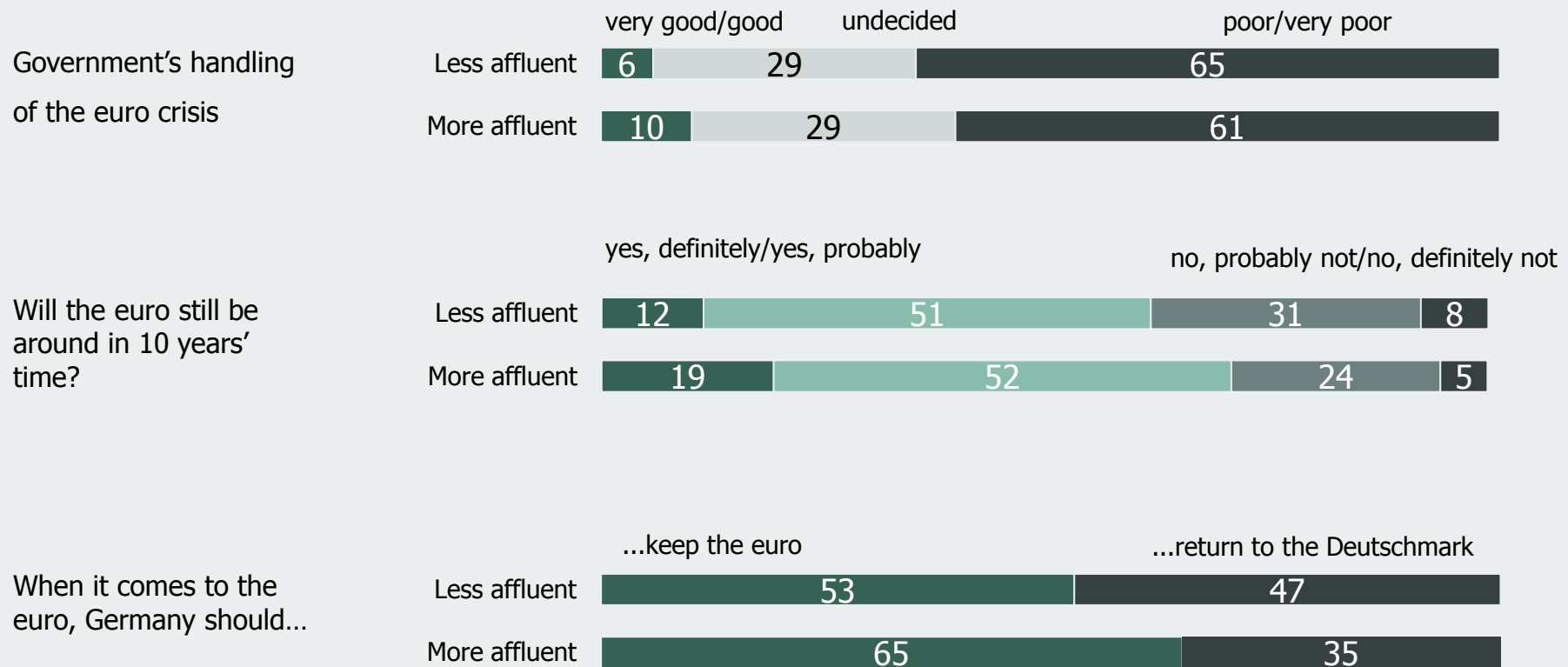


Wealthier private investors are optimistic about the future of the euro.

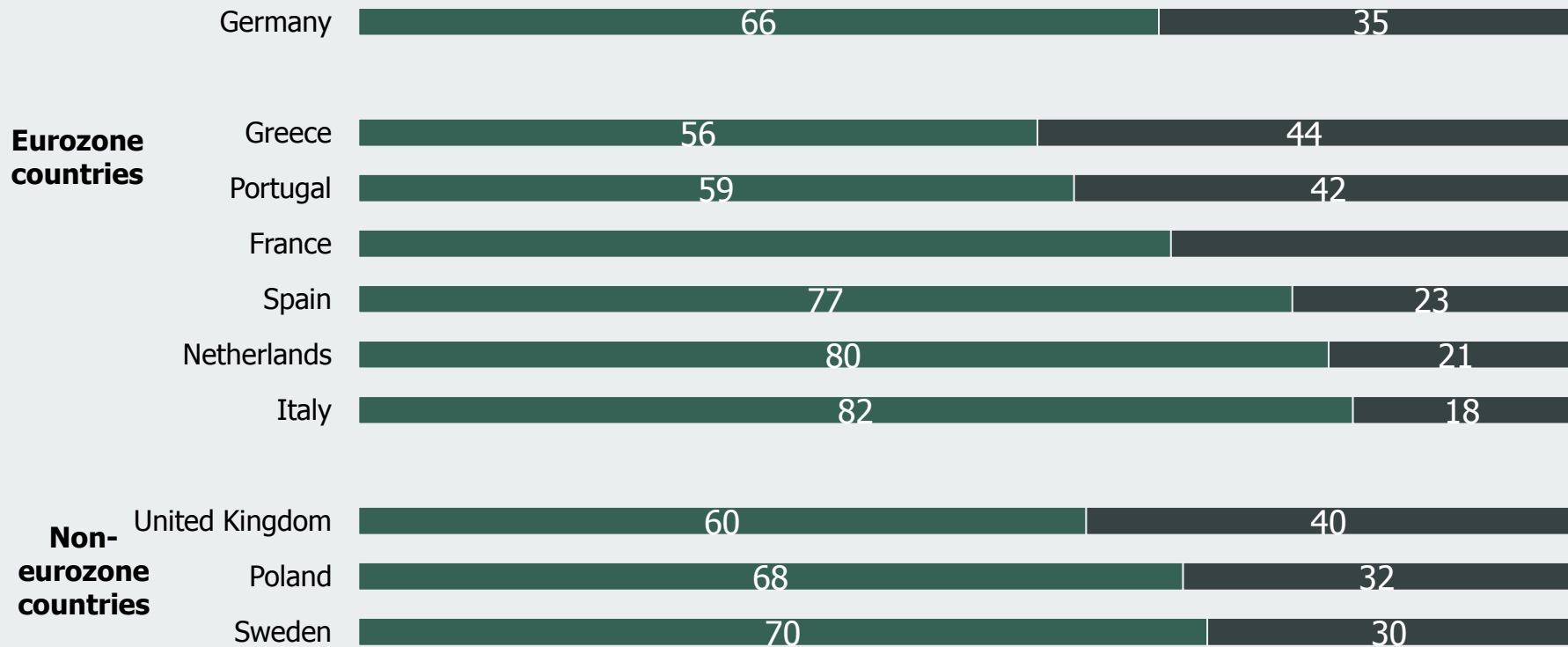

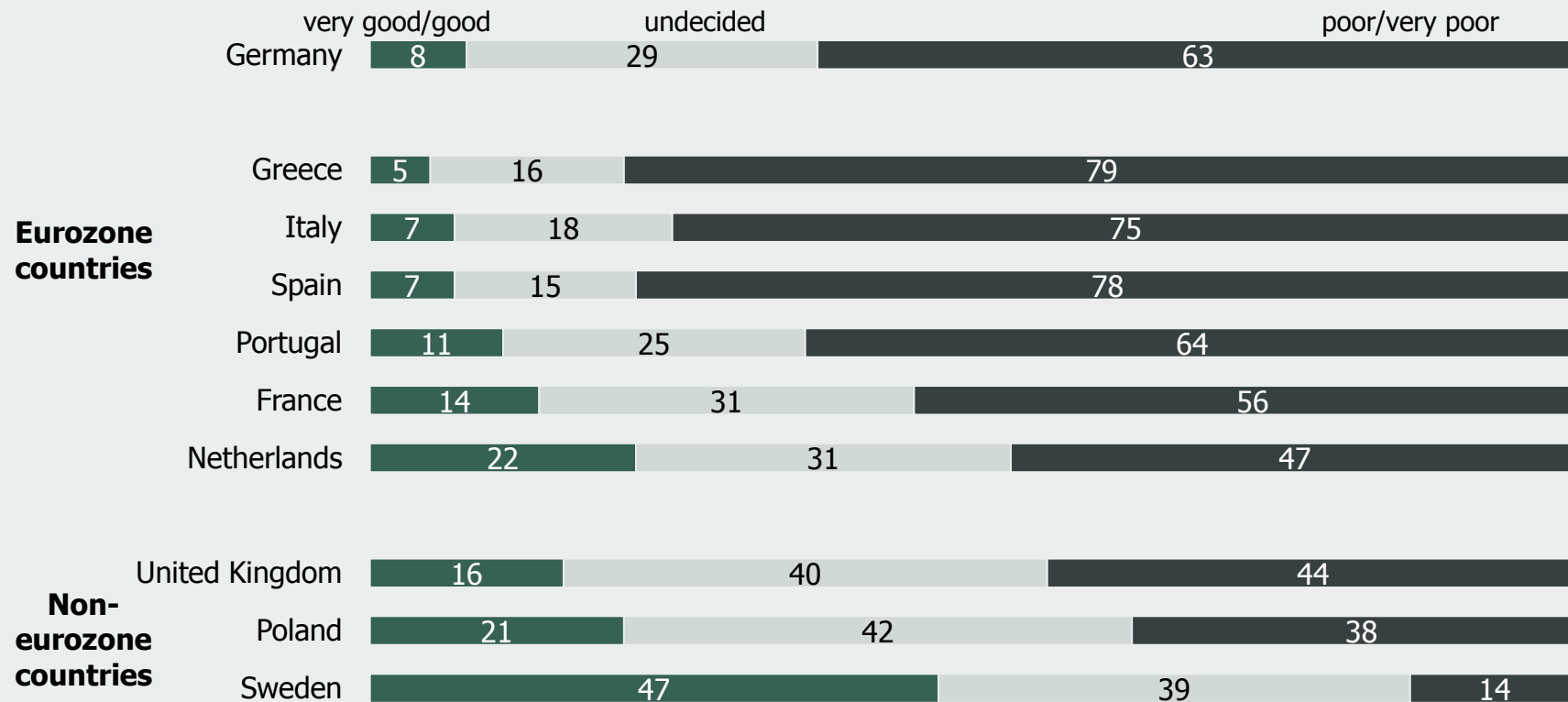

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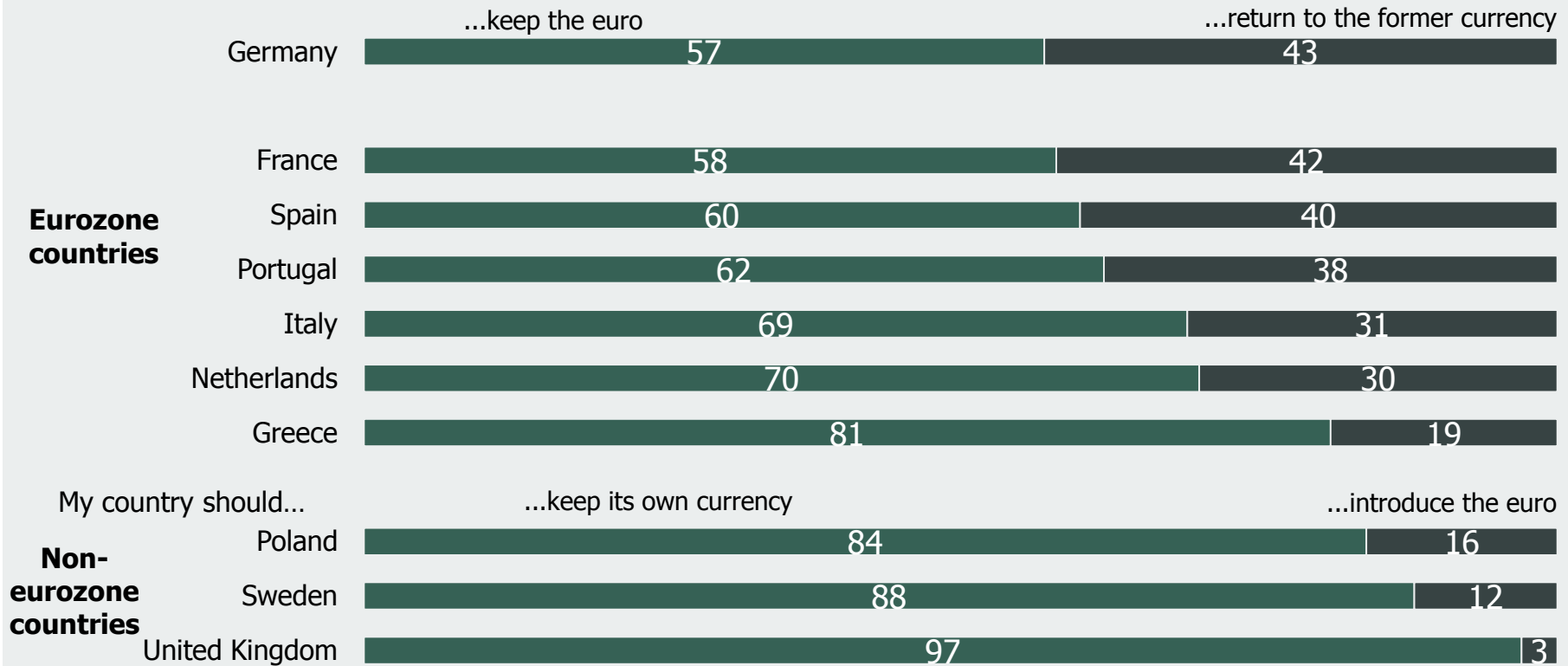

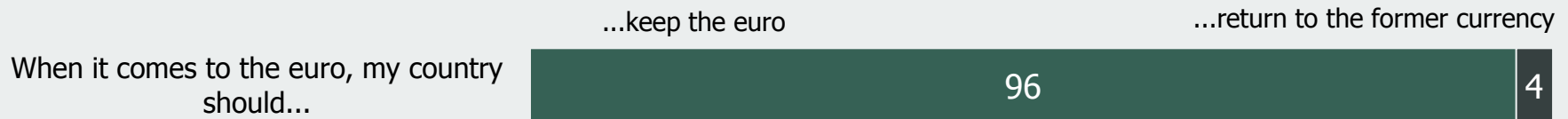
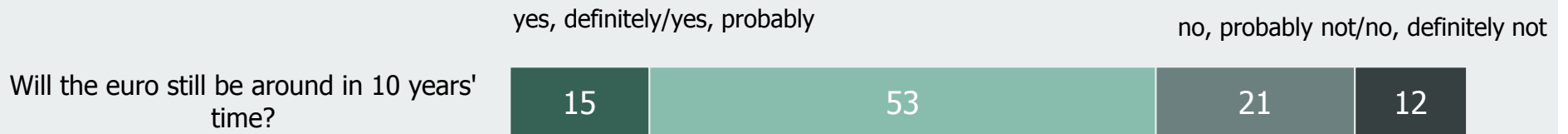
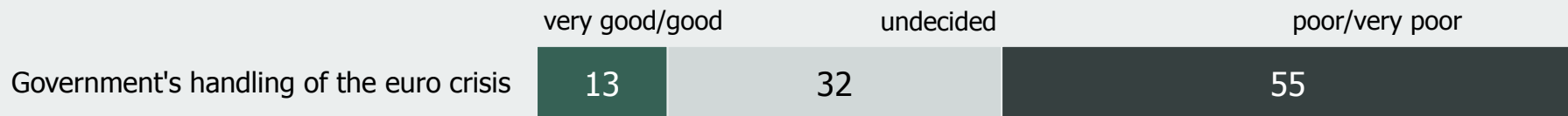
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Americans also believe in the euro.

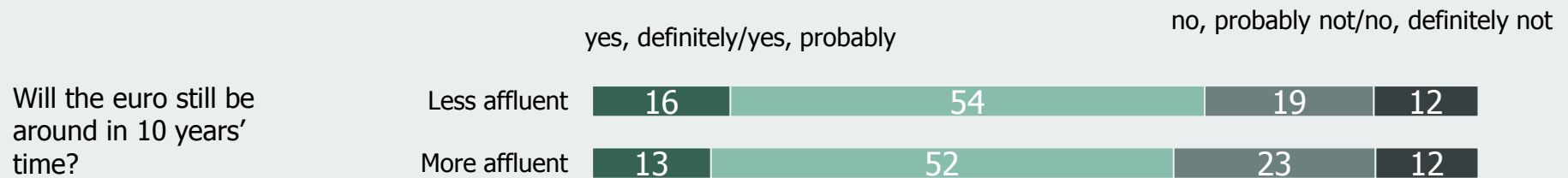
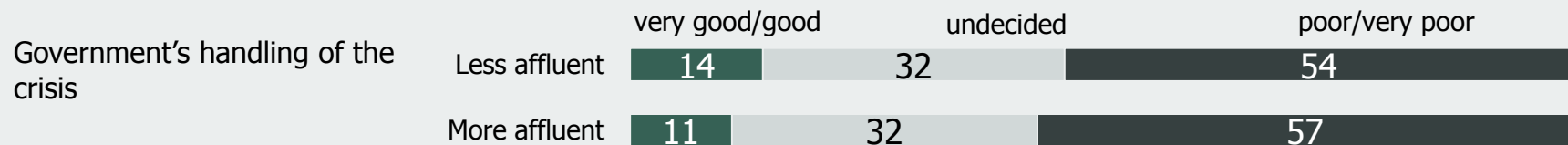


Regardless of their wealth, Americans hope the euro will stay.
